# **International Advisory Committee 2011**

#### Sharing our Fourth Day Vision with Representatives from around the world!

The 2011 International Advisory Committee (IAC) met in Nashville this October. This year's theme, **"It's About Christ"** helped focus our discussion and decisions on Christ and not ourselves. The 60-member group consisted of Emmaus and Chrysalis Regional Leaders and representatives from all over the United States. There were international members representing the United Kingdom, Jamaica, St. Maarten, Germany, Barbados, Ghana, Philippines, St. Vincent, Australia, Bahamas and South Africa, as well as Regional Leaders serving Europe and Latin America and the Caribbean.

On Friday evening, we learned about the "Charism of Emmaus," heard the opening talk from Sarah Wilke, Publisher of The Upper Room, and ended with "Lamb of God," a Communion service using clowns. On Saturday, Kate Dickinson, the new Fourth Day Coordinator spoke about the "Intentionality of Emmaus and Chrysalis" as it relates to living in the fourth day. Two members of our International Ministries department at The Upper Room spoke on relationships between *The Upper Room* daily devotional and Emmaus/Chrysalis.

On Saturday, Regional Leaders reported on the progress of the Leadership Development Events in the United States. There was a report on the first "Face to Face" event in June and July. Face to Face is a hybrid of the Walk to Emmaus movement for retired persons, and is currently being tested and evaluated.

It was announced that new metal neck crosses will be available in December 2011. It was also reported that there is an overwhelming positive response to the new Thursday Night Movie for the Walk to Emmaus.

The majority of the afternoon was spent addressing requests and questions about the international model that were made by Emmaus/Chrysalis communities. We ended the day with a report from Victor Perez, our Regional Leader for Latin America and the Carribbean, with a request for all members to make a donation to "The Gift" fund. Totals for the day amounted to \$4,300 and will be earmarked for the new start-up community in the Phillipines.



On Sunday, we began with morning devotions, and time for all members to talk about a "bright spot" from their community this past year. The former International Director made the final presentation on the exciting times before us and we concluded with a worship service in The Upper Room Chapel.

Our time together proved to be a time for information, spiritual growth and wonderful fellowship. Next year's meeting will be October 19-21, 2012.


### NEW Emmaus & Chrysalis Devotional Books



### Hungry at Christmas Time

What a metaphor – "hungry" – at a time when there are Christmas parties and celebrations everywhere. For instance, this week alone, there are four office celebrations with food. While I am very aware the some people do experience great physical hunger during this time, I am thankful that physical "hunger" is not on my list of needs.

This article is titled "Hungry at Christmas time" because regardless of how well fed we may be blessed to be, we all experience another hunger, one that feels a lot like a physical hunger, but isn't. The symptoms are similar enough to take on an ache of emptiness and make me weak and vulnerable to temptation, but instead of craving pumpkin pie, or broccoli casserole, the ache is for spiritual nourishment.

While reading a book by Robert Benson called *Living Prayer*, I realized there are a lot of people who are longing and searching for real sustenance in their spiritual lives. In his book Benson explains, "It is a life lived at attention that I seek, a life in which prayer has woven itself into the very fabric of my days, a life in which prayer has become a constant, as regular as breathing out and breathing in."
