The room was triangular in shape with stained glass windows facing the east, a triangular kneeling altar in the center of the room and a complete set of paintings by Kenneth Wyatt of the disciples and Jesus along the west wall of the room. My friends knew that if I couldn't be found and if I happened to actually not be answering my phone, then I could be found in that room. It was a safe place, a quiet place, and a place that in the middle of the craziness of college, sick family members, my own health and mind going out of control, I could go and be along with God.

That place for me has changed as life has pushed me forward. In the weeks spent at the hospitals in Lubbock with mom is was a dusty stairwell. When I lived in Lorenzo, TX, it was a few miles from town just off the Caprock. And now here in Midland, I have several places that I sometimes go to just get to take a break from everything. None since the chapel at Wayland can truly be defined as a "Spiritual" place, but when I go there to be with my Lord, they are just that.

Challenge

While I am never one to say **"YOU MUST HAVE A QUIET** TIME." I do see the validity in getting alone and being quiet in the presence of God. For some, that can go into their home office, shut the door and they are there. For others, they get in the car and go for a drive. I know of one man back home in Olton that spends most of His time with God while working cattle on the back of a horse. The place doesn't matter, the frequency really doesn't matter. What matters is that you go to that place often. You seek God's grace, God's guidance, and God's love often. Do you have a place that you go to to tune out the world and be alone with God? If not, I challenge you to find such a place this year.
