Boy's Flight #53


As Marta mentioned above, we are joining forces with Rainbow's End Emmaus in Odessa host Boy's Flight #53.

Reunion Group Information Updates



Candlelight


Candlelight will be in the East Room of the Dorothy Garrett Coliseum, labeled building 5 on the map above.
