From the Community Spiritual Director...

Greetings from the Spiritual Dude:

First and foremost I think that I need to introduce myself. My name is Glenn Pipes and

I am the current spiritual director on the Hi Sky Emmaus board. I came to this position quite by accident (remember that there are no accidents or coincidents). Dean Cook invited me to join the board and help with the spiritual duties and then one thing led to another and I inherited the director position by default. Praise God from whom all blessings flow!

Most of you know that I am currently the pastor at Wilshire Park Baptist Church. My Emmaus experience has its roots in the Rainbows End Emmaus community. I was a pilgrim on walk #18 at Circle 6 in 1994. God's grace was poured out on me in many ways and I became active as a worker and speaker at various walks after my initial pilgrim experience.

In May of 1998, while working a men's walk, the Lord spoke to me clearly and distinctly late one Saturday night in the upstairs chapel in the tabernacle.

God called me to surrender my life to full-time ministry and carry His Word to as many as possible. Please let me warn each one who is reading this column. Be very careful how you approach the Emmaus weekend. God is still in the miracle business and He uses ordinary people for extraordinary purposes.

God called me to give up a 28 year law practice in Odessa and surrender totally to His divine will. My wife and I sold everything we owned and moved to Fort Worth to attend Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary and get the training needed to follow His will in our lives. Can you say Lawyer/Preacher? That phrase has open many doors and been the catalyst for discussions about what can happen on a Walk to Emmaus. The rest, as they say, is history!

That late night session in the small upstairs chapel at Circle 6 changed my life forever.

He clearly spoke to me and said, "Whom shall I send and who will go for us?" And I humbly

responded, "Here am I Lord, send me!" When He calls your name, will you be listening? How

will you respond?
