LAY DIRECTOR

- You must have attended a Walk to Emmaus as a pilgrim. (Thank you for your help Captain Obvious.)
- Serve on a walk weekend as an Assistant Table Leader.
- 3. Serve as a Table Leader.
- 4. Experience the great joy of the serving in the background on the Servant Team.
- 5. Sit at the St. Elsewhere table serving in the role of a new, first-time, Assistant Lay Director.

- 6. Serve again as an Assistant Lay Director...this time you're the experienced ALD.
- 7. Show spiritual and technical readiness to be a leader for the three day weekend.
- 8. Be actively involved in your church and in a reunion group.
- 9. Be willing to lead the Walk Weekend according to The Upper Room Emmaus model/covenant.
- 10. Actively participate in the Hi-Sky Emmaus 4th Day activities.

Four Reasons Why Christian Action Is So Important?

1) You are never more like Christ than when you are serving others!

In Philippians 2:5-8, it says, "Have among yourselves the same attitude that is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though He was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, He emptied Himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness; and found to be human in appearance; He humbled Himself, becoming obedient to death, even death on a cross!"

2) Serving others allows us to understand the joy that follows sacrifice!

In Hebrews 12:2, it says, "For the sake of the joy that lay before Him, He endured the Cross and despised its shame." Jesus endured the pain and shame of the cross because He knew what would come out of it. Sometimes service is not pretty, but the joys and satisfaction that will result is worth every effort.

3) Serving others points people to Christ!

Matthew 5:16 says, "Just so, your light must shine before others so that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father." When we serve others, it brings glory to God and makes people think, "I wonder why he did that for me?" or "What makes her different?" Service is proof that we love God and it helps draw others to Him and His Church. "Actions speak louder than words" is an old saying and it sure is true!

4) Serving others is the way we show our love for God!

In Hebrews 6:10, it says, "For God is not unjust so as to overlook your work and the love you have demonstrated for His Name by having served and continuing to serve the holy ones." God is so proud and so happy when we serve others. And, while others may forget what you have done, Christ will never forget!
