When I began serving on Walk teams, I remember trying to memorize the "**Prayer to the Holy Spirit.**" During this journey, I looked for guidance from the Upper Room to help me understand exactly what I was praying. Here are some interesting facts that I learned.

Did you know that this prayer is spoken fourteen times on a Walk weekend, at every Emmaus event/meeting, and at weekly reunion group meetings around the world? Did you

know that its history is as a responsive prayer from the eleventh (or twelfth) century including parts of Psalm 104:30. Wow! It's simply amazing to think that we recite a prayer that has been prayed for so long! So, what does it all mean? According to the Upper Room, this is why Emmaus prays the "**Prayer to the Holy Spirit**":

"Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in us the fire of your love."

We're asking God to be in our hearts and create in us a desire to have the same love that is in Jesus.

"*Send forth your Spirit, and we shall be created. And you shall renew the face of the earth.*" We're asking God's Spirit for a re-creation to change people and all of God's creation.

"O God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by that same Holy Spirit, we may be truly wise and ever enjoy your consolations."

We are calling on God to help us become like the great men and women of faith who lived in true wisdom with God and each other.

"Through Christ our Lord. Amen."

This is a scripture reference from John 14:13, "And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father."

Through this powerful prayer, we are able to focus on three aspects of God's call for a renewed life in this world: (1) love God as our first love; (2) treat all others as God's children; and, (3) follow God's will which is a holy gift to us. **PRAYER IS POWERFUL!**
