
### **GREETINGS HI-SKY EMMAUS COMMUNITY!**

### **Greetings Hi-Sky Community,**



# What Is Agape?

**gape:** (<u>/ˈægəpiː/<sup>[1]</sup></u> or <u>/ˈægəpɪ/</u>;<sup>[2]</sup> <u>Classical Greek</u>: ἀγάπη, agápē; Modern Greek: αγάπη <sub>IPA:</sub> [aˈɣapi]

<u>Definition</u>: Agape is selfless, sacrificial, unconditional love, the highest of the four types of love in the Bible. This Greek word, and variations of it, are found throughout the New Testament.

Agape love is unconditional or sacrificial love: the self-sacrificing love of God for His people and of His people for Him. This is the highest love as it is charitable love and it is love that Christians exemplify - not only by acts of giving but also by providing for the welfare and betterment of others through these selfless acts. Agape love is being the hands and feet of Christ. It is simply and purely loving people for the sake of showing Christ's love. Agape love perfectly describes the kind of love Jesus Christ has for his Father and for his followers:

"Whoever has my commands and keeps them is the one who loves me. The one who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love them and show myself to them." (John 14:21, NIV)
